SUMMARY OF PROPOSED PROJECT

PROJECT TO BUILD SCHOOL IN SNAKE ISLAND-NIGERIA

SUMA had the opportunity to visit the Island on Mission trip in May 2016 to one of the six communities in Igbologun-Nigeria. During this mission trip we discovered many children just wandering about the in the community. Later to discover that they were mostly children from single mothers. Most of the mothers got pregnant by Sailors who came with ships to the Island to the sea port.

As depicted in the pictures in 2016 SUMA provided Life Jackets and Medical Care aim of strengthening and improving the life of the children and the community in snake island-Nigeria. The children there are living in extreme poverty where most of them find it difficult to attend school.

Snake Island is an Island very close to two very important and busy sea ports in Lagos Nigeria. Snake Island is 14 Kilometers in length and 1.4 Kilometers wide, located opposite Tin Can Island Port, Apapa. The name Snake Island came about because the Island is shaped like an elongated view from the sky make look like a Snake. It has immediate access to the open sea. The Island is only accessible by boats.

THE IMMIDIATE REQUIREMENT

It was the compassion for these children that led to urgent need to build a place where they can be housed and study properly taken care of by able hands.

The idea of the building will be at the stages, allowing for growth project expansion over time.

The goal has three key priorities

- ➤ Purchase land and build schools- For the less privileged children in Snake Island and establishing a good quality of education. We believe that every child should be safe from drowning and must have access to education.
- > Build clinics The promoting of **healthy lives and well-being** is essential for the children in the Island.
- > Supply additional life jackets to families in order to reduce the incidents of drowning in the Island while at the same time **promoting education**.

PURCHASE OF LAND AND SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION

- 16 Rooms Dormitory Structure building to house about 120 of these children.
- 2 units of this rooms will accommodate the House Masters or Mistress.
- 4 units Rooms will contain the Restrooms and Bath Rooms.
- 4 Room Building to Serve as Administration Office, Sick Bay and Store.

FIXTURES AND FITTINGS

Build dormitories and provide personal support, academic programs and empowerment academic programs and a leadership & empowerment curriculum.

PROJECT ESTIMATE COST - THREE LOCATIONS

THE PLANNED SCHOOL PROJECT IS ENVISAGED FOR 3 LOCATIONS ACROSS NIGERIA AS PER OUR INITIAL SUBMISSION. 34 MILLION NAIRA (APPROX. \$92.2K USD). HOWEVER, THE PROJECT WILL TAKE A PHASE APPROACH STARTING WITH SNAKE ISLAND.
